5. Results of the logo contest will be shared at the Whatsapp group at November 30 at 12.00 West European time!
6. Group B will share the years among themselves. (Turkey, Romania and Latvia)
7. All countries will use the template for the topics.
8. All countries will work out their own two years and also make presentations of of one year of the other countries in their group.
